

Kiwanians Clip Herald Team, 13-2

Kiwanis continued its unbeaten pace in second half Little League play Wednesday, whipping the Brownsville Herald, 13-2.

The winners who now have six straight triumphs for the second half of the schedule, scored nine runs in the second inning after the Herald had opened the scoring with two tallies in the top of the same frame.
