

## Kiwanis And JSL Grab LL Triumphs

Kiwanis and Junior Service League took Monday Little League victories in East and West Brownsville league play.

The Kiwanians, first half champions of the eastern section ran their second half record to four wins and no losses as they blanked Mercury, 10-0 Junior Service League stopped Pan American Bank, 10-3 in West league play.

For Kiwanis, Roberto Rocha gave up a single to Jose Rubio in the first inning but completely stifled the Mercury hitters the rest of the way. He walked only two men and struck out nine. Two runs each in the first, fourth and fifth innigs and four in the third accounted for the winning margin.

Junior Service got eight hits and scored in every inning to subdue Pan American. The chalked up two runs in the first, one in the second, three in the third, another in the fourth and three in the fifth.
