Francisco Solis was the winning pitcher, going all the way with Francisco Pina as his battery mate. Sam Walker started for Kiwanis but was batted from the box in the first frame with Scott Persons finishing up. Lauro Vera worked behind the plate.

Each team used two pitchers. Tony Martinez started for Mercury and gave way to Hector Solis in the fifth. Joe Rubio was the catcher. For Kiwanis Mike Reese started but was relieved by Robert Rocha in the fourth. R. Esparza went all the way behind the bat.

In West Lions League games played this week, Pan American Bank scored two victories. They topped the West Brownsville Lions on a 1-0 no-hitter by David Graham and outslugged Junior Service League, 14-13. A third scheduled game, between Junior Service League and Brownsville Shrimp Exchange was postponed due to wet grounds on Wednesday afternoon.
