

Little League Planned Here By Kiwanians

Brownsville will have Little League baseball this summer according to plans being made by the Kiwanis Club.

At a meeting Friday night, an eight-man sports committee, headed by M. M. Jones, was organized to direct organization of the Little League here.

TENTATIVE PLANS are for a six team league for the nine to 12-year-olds. The league will be affiliated with the national Little League organization and Brownsville teams will be eligible for national tournament play, including the Little World Series in Williamsport, Pa.

Jones said Saturday that the Kiwanis club has wired to Williamsport for a league charter. Three possible sponsors have already been contacted for the league's teams.
